

Board Member Volunteer Description Family & Community Engagement

Commitment Level: 3-5 hours per week

Requirements:

- 1. Must be PTSA member (\$12/school year). This is a requirement in order to hold a board member position.
- 2. Must be cleared to volunteer in the Kent School District. This must be completed every school year. http://www.kent.k12.wa.us/domain/1057
- 3. Must attend monthly PTSA board meetings typically held the 2nd Monday of each month.
- 4. Each board member shall be a member in good standing of the PTSA prior to assuming the roles and responsibilities of the position.

Training:

You will be trained by the PTSA president. You should also plan to attend one Washington State PTA sponsored training per year.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Work with other PTSA leaders to assess the needs of our Emerald Park community, and then develop PTSA goals and objectives to meet those needs.
- 2. Act as the PTSA representative at planning meetings for school events, i.e. Jog-a-thon, Reading Night, Math Night, Multicultural Night, etc. Return and report information to the PTSA board.
- 3. Act as the PTSA representative at student council meetings. Return and report information to the PTSA board.
