Commitment Level:  5-6 hours weekly in January

**Requirements:**

1. Must be cleared to volunteer in the Kent School District. This must be completed every school year.

2. Attend monthly PTSA board meetings typically held the 2nd Monday of each month, as necessary.

**Training:**

You will be trained by the former talent show chairperson.

**Responsibilities:**

1. Coordinate with PTSA and Mr. Ficken to choose dates for practices to be held (typically Tuesdays and Thursdays 3 weeks prior to the event date.)
2. In early December, update the talent show application and sent it home via Friday folders to all students.
3. Attend all student practice dates and work as a mentor to help and encourage them.
4. Collect all music and transfer it to a computer for easy playback during rehearsals and the performances.
5. Mentor the MC's, lighting, and other crew members.
6. Create a program featuring each student and their talent, as well as a certificate of participation for each child.
